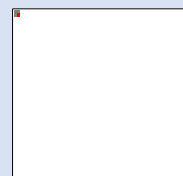

HEALTH INFORMATION

We have been made aware of a case of **threadworm** within one of our classes. Threadworm is very common in primary-aged children and is easily treated with medication available from pharmacies. As a precaution, we recommend parents remain vigilant for symptoms such as itching around the bottom, particularly at night. Good hand hygiene, especially washing hands before eating and after using the toilet, can help prevent the spread. If you are concerned your child may have symptoms, please seek advice from your pharmacist or GP.

KEEPING CHILDREN SAFE SECTION

We thought you would like to know that children are reminded that if they have a worry or concern, they can speak to any trusted adult in school or use the class worry boxes or worry monsters to share something they may find difficult to say out loud. These are checked regularly by staff so that any concerns can be followed up and children can be supported. We encourage pupils to understand that no worry is too small, and that speaking to someone is always the right thing to do. Creating a culture where children feel safe to share their worries is an important part of how we support their wellbeing and safety.

SEND SECTION

Signposting to Support for Families

Sometimes families with children who have a SEND need may benefit from advice or support beyond school. Where helpful, we can signpost parents and carers to local services and organisations that provide guidance for families of children with SEND.

Some useful services include:

- **SENDIASS Oxfordshire** – an independent service offering free advice and support to parents and carers of children with SEND.
- **Oxfordshire Parent Carers Forum** – a local network that connects families and provides opportunities to share experiences and access support.
- **Oxfordshire County Council SEND Local Offer** – an online resource outlining services, support and information available for children and young people with SEND across Oxfordshire.
